3.) Winning the Points War: SDSS is Going Platinum

- a. SDSS has achieved a gold medal rating three years in a row and this year we qualify to achieve a platinum medal awarded by APUS, which will increase our budget from \$1,000 to \$1,250. SDSS is on the clear path to achieving a Platinum rating in the near future, which will give us more wiggle room in funding and operations.
 - i. The current \$1,000 budget goes towards webhosting and subscription services and that we use for SDSS programs/projects.

4.)Crossfire Event(s)

a. We plan on holding a 4–5-person panel discussion on the situation with China and Russia that will utilize a similar format of the old CNN show, "Crossfire",

which had differing opinions and perspectives on issues to give audiences a bigger picture perspective in ways that may not be covered in regular mainstream media content.

- **b.** Tentatively, the "Crossfire" event will be held during the first or second week of October.
- c. Current list of panelists being considered are Max Daves, Dr. Mark Kass, and Dr. Larry Dietz. Sam Kessler is host. We are also looking for one or two other possible panelists that have professional and academic backgrounds on Asia, SE Asia, China, and Russia as well.

5.) Fulcrum Global Podcast Episodes

a. Multiple podcast episodes are currently in pre-production and are in motion. Some will be based on articles that will be published on the Fulcrum Global website soon and others will be interviews with guests and experts in different fields that we have invited from both AMU/APUS and in the NatSec/IC communities. All candidates interested in running for office will be required to understand both the mission and vision of SDSS/Fulcrum Global as mentioned on the About Us Page on the website, and to understand that SDSS has multiple and ongoing projects and functions, and they will need to be fully committed in the process of helping run the organization.
 - i. They will also need to realize that they will need to be an active and visible leader, as well as being a team player across the board. They will also be required to have access to all the social media platforms that we utilize too.
- **d.** Tentative dates for the SDSS election process are the following chronological outline:
 - i. September 10-20:
 - Submit a letter of intent and your most updated CV describing your background and qualifications. Also, the Letter of Intent will be read in the election ballots and should include your qualifications, reason why you want the position, and what you hope to achieve if you're elected.
 - ii. October 1-15:
 - 1. Elections/Voting
 - iii. October 18-22:
 - 1. Tallying Votes and notify candidates.
 - iv. October 26:
 - 1. Announce the winners
 - 2. Officially submit election results to APUS Student Affairs for reporting updates.
