SDSS Fulcrum Global and Professional Development Program (PDP)

From a program and operational perspective, Fulcrum Global, the digital media platform website for SDSS has been busy getting new articles reviewed and published as well as new podcast episodes on the Russia-Ukraine war and the impact on the international system, global supply chains, rising tensions with China, and overall stability of different regions in the world. In addition, the new SDSS Professional Development Program (PDP) began its first of two parts back in the Spring and recently ended with eight webinar style presentations on Open-Source Intelligence and Structural Analytical Techniques. This helped participants work on their analytical and critical thinking skills, written and oral briefing/reporting skills. In addition, they also practiced techniques via assignments as well as received constructive criticism and feedback on areas for improvement.

The PDP is considered experimental since this year is its inception, but Part 1 was a total success as it brought in real-world scenarios and understanding in simple but effective language that illustrated a big picture understanding. The second part will deal with mentorship pairing with professionals and practitioners as well as opportunities to continue developing skillsets for participants that made it to this section. The video recordings of the 8 webinar sessions are currently only available to PDP participants, however, they will eventually be made available for SDSS membership via both its Fulcrum Global website and YouTube channel at a later date.

Special thanks go out to **Nabil Rahman, (SDSS PDP Director)** and **Dan Opstal (SDSS Faculty Advisor)** for their committed involvement and assistance in helping get the leg work for the PDP developed and streamlined. It has been a real pleasure working with both of you on spearheading the creation of the new PDP flagship project and I look forward to continuing working with you both as we enter the 2nd stage of the program and onwards.
