## SDSS Afternoon Movie Series: "The Recruit" - May 3, 2025 at 2:00 PM EST

The first thing I want to alert to you is that we will be having a first of a series of SDSS afternoon film screenings based on a couple of questionnaires that we did back in the fall. Our first movie will be, "The Recruit" (2003) with Al Pacino and Colin Farrel. This film deals with focusing on CIA recruitment, however, there's plenty of themes and tradecraft teachings that apply outside of the agency and in different professions within the national security, defense, intelligence, and foreign affairs industries/communities too. A key recurring theme that this movie addresses is it repeatedly reminds us that nothing is always as they seem, and it requires the person to not only keep their wits and their intuition sharpened, but to be willing to

question their perceptions and understandings of situations, scenarios, and events as well, in order to keep the best edge possible.

In addition, this movie series will be loosely tied to the work we've been doing with the SDSS Professional Development Program (PDP) that both Professional Development Officer (PDO), Nabil Rahman, and myself have taken it upon ourselves to have generated and fostered almost 30 webinar/workshop sessions dealing with intelligence and tradecraft education for our participants in two seasons of doing PDP that spans a 2.5 year time period. So, we're not going to be just watching the movie, but we will also be discussing it, making observations, addressing key points that apply to real world practices, and discussing stereotypes. In other words, the goal will be to dissecting it and having a good solid group discussion about it that should hopefully make it worthwhile for everyone attending it. The first movie screening will be, "The Recruit" on May 3, 2025 at 2:00 PM EST so you should allot for about 3 hours for watching and discussing it in a group format. It will be on Zoom and we will be sending the Zoom info by Email as well as sending a reminder e-mail the day before and day of the movie screening. Also, the next movie will be, "Tinker, Tailor, Soldier, Spy" and more to come. So be on the lookout and we hope to see you at our first screening this weekend!

### 1. Predicting Insider Espionage: A Five-Factor Model

a. **By:** Frank C. Danesyb. **Published:** 2024

- c. **Summary:** Insider espionage has destabilized governments, jeopardized national security and critical infrastructures, diminished the economic strength of nations, and cost lives. Deterrence and detection the two methods most used to combat this threat often prove ineffective. The author, therefore, suggests placing more emphasis on prediction. This book is based on a four-year research project in which the author studied hundreds of cases of insider espionage in the government and private sectors across various countries. The project led to the development of the author's Five-Factor Model of Insider Espionage, which he validated through multiple case analyses and a cross-case synthesis. This model aims to provide a framework to predict and thus mitigate the risks associated with insider espionage. The book will familiarize readers with the model and the underlying concepts.
